St. Anne's Care Club is an out of school club that was designed specifically for children who attend St. Anne's Primary and Nursery School. We want the children who attend the club to feel safe and secure in familiar surroundings and with people they know. The setting employs a combination of qualified and experienced members of staff, who endeavor to provide a professional childcare service of the highest standards, and run the club.

Our mission.

St. Anne's Care Club aims to provide high quality, affordable and accessible childcare for parents who have childcare needs due to work, education etc.

St. Anne's Care Club aims to provide children with somewhere that they can relax, feel safe and have fun! As a team we are constantly evaluating what we offer and provide the children.

At present we provide the children with:

- A variety of fun and challenging adult and child led activities.
- Outdoor play in a safe and exciting environment.

- Well planned local outings e.g. park.
- A morning and afternoon snack.
- The opportunity to celebrate a range of cultural festivals.
- Opportunities to grow and cook their own snack

Where are we?

We are situated upstairs in the infant building and our entrance is via the infant building main door, entry is by intercom, which is clearly labeled. At St. Anne's Care Club safety is paramount; we follow a firm policy with regard to safety. CCTV cameras are set up throughout the school and walkie-talkies are used as and when necessary.

Food.

At the club we offer the children with a breakfast and a light afternoon snack. We follow a healthy eating policy; therefore will provide a healthy and nutritious snack, while also offering a wide variety of foods to try e.g. foods from different cultures.

Breakfast consist of a choice of healthy cereals, toast, fresh fruit and a choice of drinks (milk or water).

Afternoon snacks are planned in advance with the children's help, and is displayed on the parent notice board. We always have fresh water and fruit on offer for your child to help themselves.

St. Anne's Care Club caters for children with food allergies, cultural needs and medical diets.

During the school holiday breakfast and snacks are still provided, but children will need to bring a packed lunch with them.

During the holiday we ask children to wear appropriate clothing and footwear. Younger children may need a change of clothing.

We have a 5 star food hygiene rating issued by Oldham Trading Standards.

Opening times and Session Details

St. Anne's Care Club opens for 50 weeks of the year. Christmas closure is reviewed annually.

All sessions booked are payable unless two weeks written notice is given. Therefore, any sessions cancelled without the required notice will be chargeable.
Unfortunately, we can not operate with such lenience during school holidays. Therefore once a session has been booked the fee is still payable, in the event of illness holiday care is still chargeable. We do however provide a 'cut off' date for cancellations during school closures

Register, Toileting and hand washing.

Afternoon snack, free play, adult led activities.

4:00pm - 4:45pm

Outdoor play (weather permitting).
A variety of resources are available during outdoor play such as, bats, balls, rideabouts etc.

4:45pm - 4:55pm

Tidy up time outdoor and indoor.

4:55pm - 5:05pm

Wash hands, milk and fruit provided (if available).

5:05pm - 5:30pm

Children take part in activities such as 'Twister', 'Bingo' etc.
