

English: In English our class text is “The Pied Piper of Hamelin” By Michael Morpurgo & Emma Chichester Clark. We will be creating character descriptions and setting descriptions throughout this text and producing letters for different audiences. We will have a focus on grammar and punctuation this half term also and ensuring children are secure with basic skills

Maths: In Maths the year 3s will be continuing to learn about fractions, they will then move onto time, properties of shape and then towards the end of the half term the children will focus on mass and capacity. The year 4s will be learning decimals to start, time, money, properties of shape and position and direction.

Science: In science we will be learning about sound. The children will learn: How sound is made, how sound travels, know to associate sound with vibrations and understand what happens to sound as it travels away from its source.

Geography: In Geography the children will be completing a European Comparison between the UK and Germany. They will complete a study to compare the two countries to identify their similarities and differences. The children will compare population, size, capital cities, major cities, government, climate and the currency used in each coun-

DT– Our DT this half term is based on cooking and nutrition. The children will be looking at different German foods and making their own German dish.
