English: In English we will be reading Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. During this unit we will be retelling the story in our own words, writing a poem and writing an information text.

Maths: In Maths we will be continuing to look at addition and subtraction. During this half term we will also be learning about money and shapes. . RE: Baptism– this unit aims to deepen children's understanding of what it means to belong through exploring the celebration and ways in which people of faith welcome babies.

Geography: In Geography we will be learning about the Equator. Looking at where the Equator is located, focusing on the physical and human features of countries near the Equator and comparing them to the north and south poles..

Topic:

Why can't penguins live near the Equator?



Art: This half term the children will be learning about collage. Children will learn how to create textured collages from a variety of media. Children will learn how to make a mosaic.

Science:

In Science we will be learning about seasons, The children will learn about the four seasons and the changes which occur between the seasons.

Homework: Homework will be set every **Thursday** and must be returned the following **Wednesday**. This includes reading books which need to be returned to be changed. Children need to read their books and fill out their reading records. We encourage all parents to listen to their child read and to also sign the reading record to confirm the book has been read. The children will have their homework and reading book in their homework folders on Thursday.

PSHE: Communication— Children will practice recognising their feelings and learn ways in which they can express their feelings to others. Recognise that communication is an important two way

Computing:

The computing unit for this half term is using algorithms to help complete a range of tasks. As well as using technology to complete research and record the data collected .

Music:

In this unit the children will focus on two songs; rhythm in the way we walk and the banana rap

This unit is a physical skills unit. The children will focus on coordination and improving their agility while completing a range of movements.
