English: In English we will be reading Izzy Gizmo, Flight School and Taking flight. During this unit we will be writing a persuasive piece of writing, retelling the story in our own words, using the story to create our own story and an information text.

<u>RE</u> Jesus friend to everyone. In this unit children will enjoy stories of Jesus' miracles and understand that Jesus was an extraordinary person who welcomed everyone as a friend.

<u>**History**</u>: In History we will be learning about the Wright brothers and Amy Johnson. We will look at the timeline of the first aeroplane and why their accomplishments were special.

<u>DT</u>: During this half term children will be making bags for lzzy Gizmo. Children will learn a range of joining techniques as they make a tool bag for lzzy Gizmo.

Science: In Science we will be learning about everyday materials. The children will learn about a range of materials and their properties are.

PSHE: Making and breaking relationships– Children will be learning have to resolve conflicts. Focusing on how to make and maintain friendships.

Computing:

The computing unit for this half term is animated stories. Children will learn how to create their own animated stories and understand how to add pictures and voice overs to their stories.

<u>Music</u>: In this unit the children will focus on a song called 'In the Groove' by Joanna Mangona.

PE: This unit is a health and fitness unit. The children will focus on agility and ways they can move around while maintaining control. Children will learn to challenge themselves and ask for help

Children need to read their books and fill out their reading records. We encourage all parents to listen to their child read and to also sign the reading record to confirm the book has been read.
