

Green Class Half Termly Newsletter Summer 1



English: In English we will be reading ' The Queens Kickers', 'The Kings Pants', 'The Kings Coronation' and ' Winnie The Pooh Meets King Charles' . During this unit we will be retelling the story in our own words, using the story to create our own story, writing a poem and an information text.

<u>Maths:</u> In Maths we will be continuing to learn about multiplication and division, where children will learn to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Next children learn about fractions Children will learn about half and quarters. We will then start a unit on time.

<u>RE</u>: Bible—Why is it a special book? During this unit children will gain an understanding of the Bible, its contents, presentation and importance to Christians. Children will develop an understanding of holy books from faiths other than Christianity and their significance in the lives of believers.

<u>History</u>: In History we will be about Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Elizabeth II. We will compare the two Queens and their reigns. We will look what life was like during Queen Elizabeth I reign and discuss if we would have liked to live during her rule. <u>Topic:</u>

<u>Art</u>: During this unit children will look at different ways in which they can manipulate a range of materials. Children will gain an understanding of sculptures and will make their own.

Science: In Science we are continuing the unit of animal including human. We will be focusing on humans, Children will learn which senses are associated with each body part. We will also be looking at how humans needs change as we get older.

PSHE: Change and loss– During this unit children will ways in which can help when we they are experiencing a period of change of loss.

Computing:

The computing unit for this half term is algorithms. Children will learn how algorithms are used with a range of technology. Children will learn how to follow algorithms and create their own.

<u>Music</u>: In this unit the children will focus on a song called 'In the Groove' by Joanna Mangona.

<u>PE</u>: This unit is a social skills unit. The children will work together and think of ways to help each other. The focus will be on balance and being able to balance standing, seated and after jumping.

Homework: Homework will be set every **Friday** and must be returned the following **Thursday**. This includes reading books which need to be returned to be changed. Children need to read their books and fill out their reading records. We encourage all parents to listen to their child read and to also sign the reading record to confirm the book has been read. The children will have their homework and reading book in their homework folders on Fridays.
