English: In English, we will use the following books this half term. Lila and the Secret of the rain, Mami Miti and the Trees of Kenya, The Ugly five and The not Bad Animals book.

Maths:

For the final term the children will finish the unit of work on fractions before they complete their final unit of work on position and direction.

Science: In the final Science unit this half term the children will be learning about plants. We will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

Geography We will be comparing Kenya to the UK. We will be learning where Kenya is and what animals live there compared to the UK and we will learn what a typical day would be like for a child in Kenya

DT—The children will be learning about puppets and they will learn how to join materials together in different ways to make puppets and finger puppets.

RE: For the final term the children will finish their unit of work on the "good news" Christians believe Jesus Brings? They will continue to learn about the good news that Jesus brings.

PSHE: In My Happy Mind we will be learning about will learn what Relate means and which different people they can Relate to.

Computing: The computing unit for this half term is about questioning. The children will use yes or no questions to separate data, they will construct a binary tree and use pictograms

Music: Reflect, rewind and reply. This unit of work consolidates the learning that has occurred during the year. All the learning is focused around revisiting songs and musical activities.

PE: The final PE unit for this year is a health and fitness unit. The children will learn the importance of warming up and cooling down and refine their floor work,

Homework: Homework will be set every **Friday** and must be returned the following **Thursday** This includes reading books which need to be returned to be changed. Children need to read their books and change them at least once a week.
